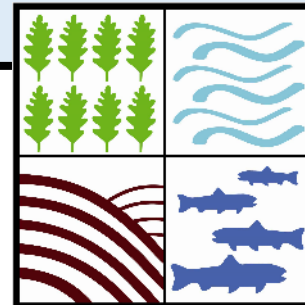




SO... What Exactly is a Stormwater Collaborative?

- ***Whatever you want or need it to be!***

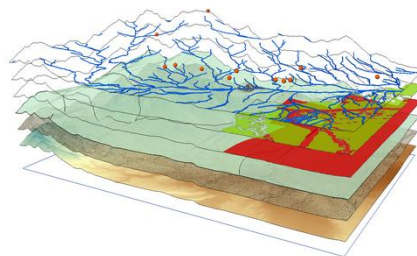

- Green stormwater infrastructure like bioretention and pervious pavements have the potential to address the issue, while providing other benefits

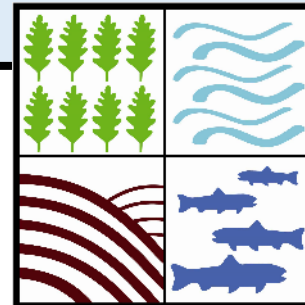

Issued: May 24, 2018

Effective: July 1, 2019
